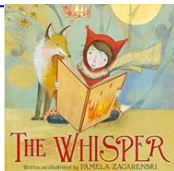
The Mysteries of Harris Burdick by Chris Van Allsburg.

Writing

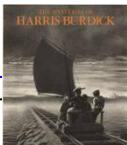
Write sections of narrative inspired images.

Maths: Place Value

Count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100.

Find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number.

Recognise the place value of each digit in a 3-digit number.

Compare and order numbers up to 1000.

Identify/represent numbers using different models and images.

Read and write numbers up to 1000 in numbers and words.

Solve number problems and practical problems.

Music

Listen with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing memory using a range of percussion.

Geography

Know what Egger produces and why it is located in Hexham.

Understand about the different stages of production.

Know how Egger has affected employment within Hexham.

Know the environmental impacts of Egger and what is done to mitigate the risks.
